ANM Data API

TypeScript, Node.js, Express, AWS S3, Terraform, node-cron

- Replaced a legacy Python ETL with a TypeScript and Express service that synchronizes 15 public datasets from Brazil's National Mining Agency into AWS S3 in five scheduled waves, giving each dataset an isolated chain for ZIP extraction, shapefile conversion, CSV parsing, and ODS metadata so one failed download cannot block the rest.
- Served the data through REST endpoints with CSV-to-JSON conversion, pagination, and one-hour caching; notified 14 dependent database services after each sync with retries, and protected the API with Helmet, rate limiting, and API keys.

- Built the browsing and detail interfaces in React and TypeScript for a calendar of mining regulatory deadlines and sector events, with shareable links and one-click export to Google Calendar.
- Wrote the Express API and the PostgreSQL schema behind events and subscriptions, and implemented scheduled email digests with validation, delivery retries, and a guard against sending the same digest twice.

- Built a FastAPI backend with async SQLAlchemy, Alembic migrations, and modules split by domain, paired with a Next.js and React dashboard that reads server state through TanStack Query.
- Streamed batch email-classification progress to the interface with Server-Sent Events, and kept the feature working during model-API timeouts through typed exception handling and template replies.
